



## **Gloucester RFC**

Case Study

Kingsholm Stadium's original South Stand opened in 1932 and, with a capacity for just 1,800 spectators, was no longer fit for purpose for the growing club.

GL events UK more than tripled capacity at the home of Gloucester rugby, demolishing and removing the existing structure and constructing an all-seater grandstand with pre-cast concrete terraces, capable of accommodating 7,000 fans.



The design incorporated elevated hospitality boxes, located on a secondary balcony-level, high above the main spectator seating. This allowed a greater seating capacity in the main terraces; which consist of part-permanent and part demountable seating, with additional VIP areas.

The stand makes the most of every available space, incorporating club administration facilities, several restaurants, bars, concessions, conference facilities, offices and changing rooms.
